CROCHET STITCH DIRECTORY

Review the stitch tutorials to ensure your Amigurumis will come out perfect.

Chain Stitch (ch)

Make a slip knot on the hook. Bring yarn over hook from back to front and grab it with hook. Repeat.



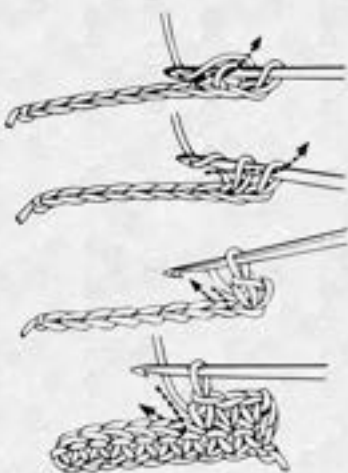
Slip Stitch (sl st)

Insert hook, yarn over and draw yarn through chain and the loop on your hook in one motion.



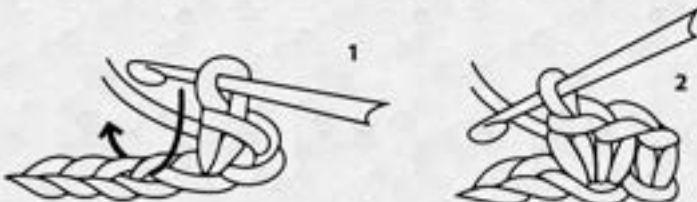
Single crochet (sc)

Follow the same instruction to make slip stitch until you draw yarn through the chain stitch and up onto the hook. There are now 2 loops on hook. Bring yarn over hook from back to front and draw it through both loops.



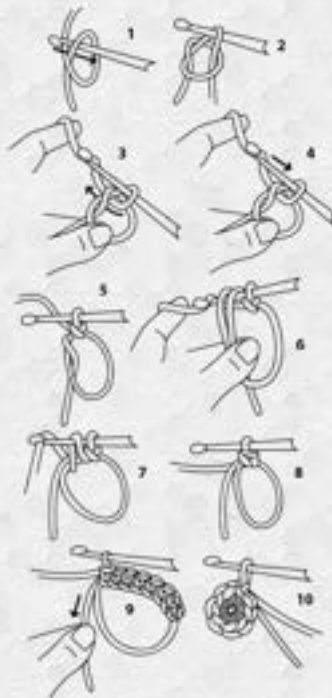
Increase (inc)

To increase, make 2 sc into every single stitch.



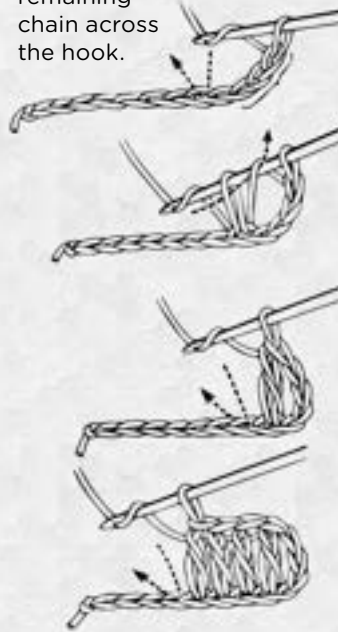
Magic ring

Loop the yarn around your fingers. Insert hook into the loop and draw up a loop loosely. Hold this loop with your thumb and middle finger and wrap the yarn on your index finger. Make a chain stitch and now you are crocheting over the loop and the yarn tail. Draw up a loop and begin your first sc. Continue to crochet over the loop and the yarn tail until you have the required number of sc mentioned in the pattern. Pull the tail yarn to close the ring.



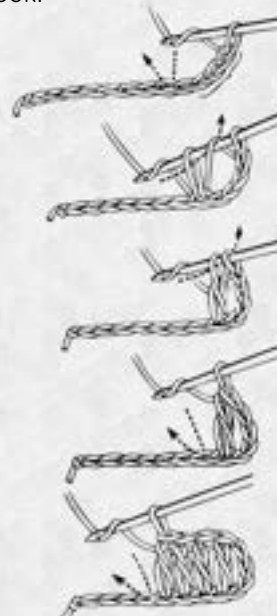
Half double crochet (hdc)

Insert hook on the 3rd chain on the left. Bring yarn over and draw it through the chain stitch and up. You now have 3 loops on the hook. Draw yarn through all 3 loops in one motion. Continue to work one half double crochet in each remaining chain across the hook.



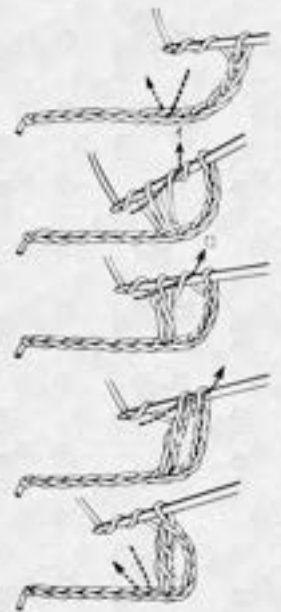
Double crochet (dc)

Yarn over, insert the hook in the 5th chain, yarn over and pull through the chain (3 loops on the hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops, (2 loops remain on the hook), yarn over, pull through the last 2 loops. Continue to work one double crochet in each remaining chain across the hook.



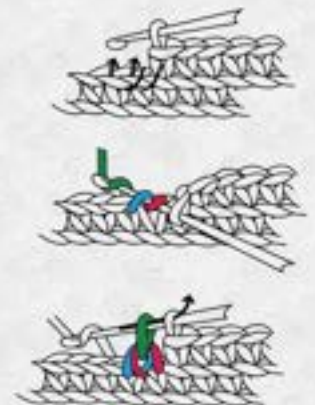
Treble crochet (tr)

Yarn over twice, insert hook into the 6th chain, yarn over and pull through (4 loops on the hook), yarn over and pull through 2 loops, yarn over and pull through 2 loops. You have now 1 loop on the hook. Continue to work one treble crochet in each remaining chain across the hook.



Decrease (invisible) (dec)

Insert hook into the front loop on the first stitch and do the same on the second stitch. You have 2 loops on the hook, yarn over, pull through and now you have 2 loops, yarn over and pull through the remaining 2 loops.

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 8001, 8990, 7569 and 8008
- Safety eyes - 7 mm
- Crochet hook D-3
- Tapwatry needle
- Polyester stuffing

Stitch glossary:

- magic ring: mr
- chain: ch
- single crochet: sc
- Increase: inc
- Decrease: dec

Head

Start with color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc
Rows 5 & 6: 24 sc.
Row 7: 6 sc, 1 dec = 21 sc
Row 8: 21 sc
Switch to color 8001.
Rows 9 - 11: 21 sc
*From now on switch colors every 2 rows, alternating black and white.
Row 12: 2 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc
Attach safety eyes between rows 10 & 11, 4 sts apart.
Row 13: 30 sc
Row 14: 30 sc
Row 15: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc
Rows 16 & 17: 36 sc
Rows 18 & 19: 36 sc
Row 20: 36 sc
Row 21: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc
Row 22: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc
Row 23: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc
Row 24: 18 sc
Insert stuffing.
Row 25: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Row 26: 6 dec = 6 sc
Fasten off in magic loop method. (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).

Body

Start with color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
*From now on switch colors every 2 rows, alternating black and white.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.
Row 5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.
Row 6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.
Rows 7 - 15: 36 sc.
Row 16: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.
Rows 17 - 19: 30 sc
Row 20: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.
Row 21: 24 sc.
Row 22: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.
Rows 23 - 25: 18 sc.
Insert stuffing.
Cut yarn, leave a tail for sewing.

Legs (mk 2)

Start with color 7569.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: back loop only (BLO) 18 sc
Rows 5 & 6: 18 sc.
Row 7: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Rows 8 & 9: 12 sc (black)
Rows 10 & 11: 12 sc (white)
Rows 12 & 13: 12 sc (black)
Rows 14 & 15: 12 sc (white)
Rows 16 & 17: 12 sc (black)
Insert stuffing.

Arms (mk 2)

Start with color 7569.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: (BLO) 18 sc.
Rows 5 & 6: 18 sc.
Row 7: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.
Rows 8 & 9: 12 sc (black)
Rows 10 & 11: 12 sc (white)
Rows 12 & 13: 12 sc (black)
Rows 14 & 15: 12 sc (white)
Rows 16 & 17: 12 sc (black)
Insert stuffing.

Ears (mk 2)

Use color 8990.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2: 6 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.
Row 4: 9 sc.
Row 5: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.
Row 6: 3 sc, 1 inc = 15 sc.
Row 7: 1 sc, 1 inc = 22 sc.
Fold base closing ear as shown in the picture.

Tail

Use color 8990.

Ch 12, turn and mk sc statinr at second chain.
Use color 7569, cut strands to 4" and insert into tail making a knot.

Assembly

- Sew head onto body.
- Sew arms onto second black stripe of body next to neck.
- Sew legs onto row 3 at bottom of body, slightly facing front.
- Sew ears between rows 16 & 17, 9 sts apart.
- Cut several black & white strands to 3.25" to make mane onto head like fringes and then unravel and trim them.
- Use color 8008 to make traces close to the eyes as shown in the picture.
- Use color 8001 to embroider nostrils in a V shape between rows 3 & 4.
- Sew tail on back.
- Optional: apply blush on cheeks.

Material:

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 6614 and 6161
- Safety eyes - 7 mm
- Crochet hook D-3
- Tapwatry needle
- Polyester stuffing

Puntos Utilizados:

- Magic ring: mr
- Chain: ch
- Single crochet: sc
- Increase: inc
- Decrease: dec
- Popcorn st: mk 5dctog in the same base st, take hook off the loop and insert in the 1st st and pull through making a Popcorn st.

Head

Use color 6614

Row 1: ch 8, turn and mk 1 sc into 3rd chain from hook, 5 sc, 3 sc tog into last ch, 5 sc, 3 sc tog in the last ch = 16 sc.
Row 2: 5 sc, 3 inc, 5 sc, 3 inc = 22 sc
Row 3: 1 inc, 5 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc) 3x, 5 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc) 3x = 28 sc.
Row 4: 5 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc = 34 sc
Row 5: 1 Popcorn st, 4 sc, 1 Popcorn st, 28 sc = 34 sts
Rows 6 - 9: 34 sc
Row 10: 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 27 sc = 32 sc
Row 11: 32 sc
Row 12: 6 inc, 26 sc = 38 sc
Row 13: 38 sc
Row 14: (1 inc, 1 sc) 6x, 26 sc = 44 sc
Rows 15 - 18: 44 sc.
Attach safety eyes between rows 13 & 14, 5 sts apart.
Row 19: (1 dec, 6 sc) 4x, 1 dec, 2 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc = 38 sc
Row 20: 28 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc = 36 sc
Row 21: (1 dec, 5 sc) 4x, dec 3 tog, 5 sc = 30 sc
Row 22: 1 dec, 4 sc = 25 sc
Row 23: 1 dec, 3 sc = 20 sc
Row 24: 1 dec, 2 sc = 15 sc.
Insert stuffing.
Row 25: 1 dec, 1 sc = 10 sc
Row 26: 5 dec = 5 sc
Fasten off in magic loop method.
(Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).

Body

Start with color 6614

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.
Row 5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.
Row 6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.
Row 7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc
Rows 8 - 15: 42 sc.
Row 16: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.
Row 17: 36 sc
Row 18: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc
Row 19: 30 sc
Row 20: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.
Rows 21 and 22: 24 sc.
Row 23: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.
Rows 24 & 25: 18 sc.
Insert stuffing.

Legs (mk 2)

Start with color 6161

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc
Row 5: 8 sc, (1 popcorn st, 1 sc) 4x, 9 sc = 24 sts.
Switch to color 6614.

Row 6: 24 sc
Row 7: 8 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc = 21 sc
Row 8: 21 sc.
Row 9: 8 sc, 3 dec, 7 sc = 18 sc
Rows 10 - 13: 18 sc
Row 14: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc
Row 15: 16 sc
Row 16: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc
Rows 17 - 19: 14 sc
Insert stuffing until half full.

Arms (mk 2)

Start with color 6161

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc = 21 sc
Row 5: 5 sc, (1 Popcorn st, 1 sc) 4x, 7 sc = 21 sc
Switch to color 6614.
Rows 6 - 9: 21 sc.
Row 10: 2 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc = 18 sc
Rows 11 - 13: 18 sc
Row 14: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc
Row 15: 16 sc
Row 16: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc
Row 17: 14 sc
Row 18: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Rows 19 & 20: 12 sc
Insert stuffing until half full.

Ears (mk 4) 2 of each color.

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Join parts with color 6614.

Tail

Use color 6614

mk 3 sts for 11 rows. Cut 3 strands to approx. 4" and insrt into tail's tip.

Assembly

- Sew head onto body.
- Sew arms onto third row from neck.
- Sew legs at bottom of body, 4 rows from body starting point.
- Sew ears onto row 18, 9 sts apart.
- Use color 6161 to embroider smiling mouth below nostrils between rows 4 & 5.
- Use color 6161 to make traces close to the eyes as shown in the picture.
- Use color 6614 to embroider navel between rows 11 & 12.
- Sew tail on back.
- Optional: apply blush on cheeks.

- Crochet hook D-3
- Tapwatry needle
- Polyester stuffing

Head

Use color 2927

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc
Rows 5 - 9: 24 sc
Row 10: 3 inc, 21 sc = 27 sc
Row 11: 1 sc, 1 inc (3x), 21 sc = 30 sc
Row 12: 2 sc, 1 inc (3x), 21 sc = 33 sc
Row 13: 3 sc, 1 inc (3x), 21 sc = 36 sc
Rows 14 - 17: 36 sc.
Attach safety eyes between rows 12 & 13, 6 sts apart.
Row 18: 3 sc, 1 dec (3x), 21 sc = 33 sc
Row 19: 33 sc
Row 20: 2 sc, 1 dec (3x), 21 sc = 30 sc
Row 21: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.
Insert stuffing.
Row 22: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc
Row 23: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Row 24: 6 dec = 6 sc
Fasten off in magic loop method. (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).

Body

Use color 2927

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.
Row 5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.
Row 6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.
Rows 7 & 8: 36 sc
Row 9: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc
Rows 10 & 11: 42 sc
Row 12: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc
Rows 13 - 15: 36 sc
Row 16: 9 sc, (1 dec, 1 sc)6x, 9 sc = 30 sc.
Rows 17 - 20: 30 sc
Row 21: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc
Rows 22 & 23: 24 sc
Row 24: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc
Row 25: 18 sc
Insert stuffing.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Ears (mk 2)

Use color 2927

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2 : 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc
Row 4: 18 sc
Fold a piece and sew at bottom as shown in the picture. Cut yarn leaving a tail for sewing.

Arms (mk 2)

Use color 8013

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc
Row 4: 18 sc
Row 5: (BLO) 18 sc
Row 6: 18 sc
Switch to color 2927.

Row 7: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.
Rows 8 - 18: 12 sc
Insert stuffing until half full.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Legs (mk 2)

Start with color 8013

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: (BLO) 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc
Rows 5 & 6: 24 sc
Switch to color 2927.
Row 7: (BLO) 24 sc
Row 8: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc
Row 9: 18 sc
Row 10: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Rows 11 - 15: 12 sc
Insert stuffing until half full.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Big horn

Use color 8013

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 3 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc
Row 3: 9 sc
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc
Row 5: 12 sc
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Small horn

Use color 8013

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 12 sc
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Tail

Use color 2927.

Mk a tail with 3 sts for 11 rows.
Cut 3 strands to 4" and insert into tip.

Assembly

- Sew head onto body.
- Sew arms onto second row from neck.
- Sew legs at bottom of body, onto row 5 facing front as shown in the picture.
- Sew ears onto rows 16 & 17, 6 sts apart.
- Sew big horn between rows 2 & 4.
- Sew small horn between rows 6 & 8.
- Use color 8013 to embroider teeth below big horn between rows 2 & 3.
- Use color 8013 to embroider smile below teeth between rows 5 & 6 as shown in the picture.
- Use color 8013 to make traces close to the eyes as shown in the picture.
- Use color 8013 to embroider navel between rows 12 & 13.
- Sew tail on back.
- Optional: apply blush on cheeks.

Row 1: 7 sc inside of mr
Row 2: 7 inc = 14 sc

Rows 5 & 6: 28 sc.
Row 7: 4 sc, (1 dec, 4 sc)4x = 24 sc
Row 8: 24 sc
Switch to color 4146.
Row 9: 24 sc
Row 10: 9 sc, 6 inc, 9 sc = 30 sc
Row 11: 30 sc
Row 12: 9 sc, (1 inc, 1 sc)6x, 9 sc = 36 sc
Row 13: 36 sc
Attach safety eyes between rows 9 & 10, 10 sts apart.
Row 14: 1 inc, 5 sc = 42 sc
Rows 15 - 18: 42 sc.
Row 19: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc
Row 20: 36 sc
Row 21: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc
Row 22: 30 sc
Row 23: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc
Row 24: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc
Insert stuffing.
Row 25: 1 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Row 26: 6 dec = 6 sc
Fasten off in magic loop method. (Insert tapestry needle into front loops of remaining sts and pull tight to close hole).

Row 5: 2 sc, 1 dec = 6 sc.
Switch to color 4146.
Rows 6 - 9: 6 sc.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Spots (mk 4)

Use color 7569

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Arms (mk 2)

Start with color 7650

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 5 sc, 1 inc = 21 sc.
Row 5: 21 sc
Row 6: (BLO) 21 sc
Switch to color 7569.
Row 7: 21 sc.
Switch to color 4146.
Row 8: 21 sc.
Row 9: 5 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.
Row s 10 & 11: 18 sc.
Row 12: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.
Row 13: 16 sc.
Row 14: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.
Row 15: 14 sc.
Row 16: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Rows 17 - 19: 12 sc.

Row 7: 7 sc, 1 dec = 16 sc.

Row 8: 16 sc.

Row 9: 6 sc, 1 dec = 14 sc.

Row 10: 14 sc.

Row 11: 5 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.

Row 12: 12 sc.

Insert stuffing.

Row 13: 4 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.

Rows 14 - 20: 10 sc.

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Use color 7650 to make loops from center to the first color switch to form front hooves.

Ears (mk 2)

Use color 4146

Row 1: 6 sc inside of magic ring.

Row 2: 6 sc.

Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 9 sc.

Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.

Row 5: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.

Rows 6 - 9: 18 sc.

Row 10: 6 dec = 12 sc.

Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Tail

Use color 4146

Ch 15, turn and start at second chain.

Cut strands of color 7569 to 4" and insert into tail tip making a knot.

Assembly

- Sew head onto body.
- Sew arms between rows 7 & 8 below neck seam.
- Sew legs between rows 5 & 6 of body.
- Sew ears between rows 16 & 17, 10 sts apart.
- Sew horns between rows 13 & 14, 3 stitches apart.
- Sew spots on back.
- Sew tail on back.
- Use color 7650 to make traces close to the eyes as shown in the picture.
- Use color 7569 to embroider nostrils onto rows 4 & 5.
- Use color 7569 to embroider smile between rows 5 & 6.
- Use color 7569 to embroider eyebrows, 1 row above eyes.
- Use color 8797, cut strands to 3.25" and insert into head to form hair.
- Optional: apply blush on cheeks and inside ears.

Material

- 1 ball of Amigurumi in each color: 8797, 3157 and 8001
- Safety eyes - 7 mm
- Crochet hook D-3
- Tapwatry needle
- Polyester stuffing

Stitch glossary:

- Magic ring: mr
- Chain: ch
- Single crochet: sc
- Increase: inc
- Decrease: dec

Head

Use color 8797

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc
Row 5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc
Row 6: 30 sc.
Row 7: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.
Row 8: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc.
Rows 9 & 10: 42 sc.
Row 11: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.
Row 12: 7 sc, 1 inc = 54 sc.
Rows 13 - 15: 54 sc.
Row 16: 7 sc, 1 dec = 48 sc.
Row 17: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc.
Row 18: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.
Attach safety eyes between rows 14 & 15, 5 sts apart.
Row 19: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc.
Row 20: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.
Row 21: 2 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.
Insert stuffing. Fasten off.

Body

Use color 8797

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.
Row 5: 3 sc, 1 inc = 30 sc.
Row 6: 4 sc, 1 inc = 36 sc.
Row 7: 5 sc, 1 inc = 42 sc
Row 8: 6 sc, 1 inc = 48 sc.
Rows 9 - 13: 48 sc.
Row 14: 6 sc, 1 dec = 42 sc.
Row 15: 42 sc.
Row 16: 5 sc, 1 dec = 36 sc.
Rows 17 - 19: 36 sc.
Row 20: 4 sc, 1 dec = 30 sc
Rows 21 & 22: 30 sc.
Row 23: 3 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.
Rows 24 & 25: 24 sc.
Row 26: 4 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.
Rows 27 & 28: 20 sc.
Insert stuffing.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Trunk

Use color 8797

Row 1: 8 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2: 8 inc = 16 sc.
Row 3: (BLO)2 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc
Row 4: 12 sc.
Row 5: 4 sc, 1 dec = 10 sc.

Rows 6 - 12: 10 sc.
Row 13: 4 sc, 1 inc = 12 sc.
Row 14: 12 sc.
Row 15: 3 sc, 1 inc = 15 sc.
Row 16: 15 sc.
Row 17: 2 sc, 1 inc = 20 sc.
Row 18: 20 sc.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Arms (mk 2)

Start with color 3157

Row 1: 7 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2: 7 inc = 14 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 21 sc
Switch to color 8797
Row 4: 21 sc
Row 5: 19 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.
Rows 6 & 7: 20 sc.
Row 8: 8 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.
Rows 9 & 10: 18 sc.
Row 11: 4 sc, 1 dec = 15 sc.
Row 12: 15 sc.
Row 13: 3 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.
Rows 14 & 15: 12 sc.
Row 16: 2 sc, 1 dec = 9 sc.
Rows 17 - 19: 9 sc.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.
Insert stuffing until half full.

Ears (mk 2)

Use color 8797

Row 1: 8 sc inside of magic ring.
Row 2: 8 inc = 16 sc.
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.
Row 4: 3 sc, 1 inc = 32 sc.
Rows 5 - 11: 32 sc.
Row 12: 2 sc, 1 dec = 24 sc.
Row 13: 4 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.
Fold in half.
Cut yarn leaving a tail for sewing.

Legs (mk 2)

Start with color 3157

Row 1: 6 sc inside of mr.
Row 2: 6 inc = 12 sc
Row 3: 1 sc, 1 inc = 18 sc.
Row 4: 2 sc, 1 inc = 24 sc.
Switch to color 8797.
Row 5: (BLO) 24 sc
Row 6: 24 sc
Row 7: 10 sc, 1 dec = 22 sc.
Row 8: 22 sc.
Row 9: 9 sc, 1 dec = 20 sc.

Row 10: 20 sc.
Row 11: 8 sc, 1 dec = 18 sc.
Rows 12 - 14: 18 sc.
Row 15: 4 sc, 1 dec = 15 sc.
Rows 16 - 18: 15 sc.
Row 19: 3 sc, 1 dec = 12 sc.
Row 20: 20 sc.
Insert stuffing until half full.
Fasten off leaving a tail for sewing.

Tail Use color 8797

Row 1: 7 sc inside of magic ring.
Rows 2 -4: 7 sc.
Row 5: 5 sc, 1 dec = 6 sc.
Rows 6 - 8: 6 sc.
Row 9: 4 sc, 1 dec = 5 sc.
Row 10: 5 sc.
Make a half pompom and tie at tails tip.

Assembly

- Sew head onto body.
- Sew arms onto row 4 from neck seam.
- Sew legs at bottom of body, 3 rows on front.
- Sew trunk below eyes.
- Sew ears starting at row 5.
- Sew tail on back.
- Use color 8001 to embroider 16 traces on trunk and nails onto feet as shown in the picture.
- Embroider traces around eyes.
- Use color 3157 to embroider mouth below trunk.
- Use color 8001 to embroider teeth.
- Use color 8797, cut strands to 4.75" and insert into head to form hair.



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
