Approx. size: 5"

Level: Confident Beginner – basic and repetitive stitches with little shaping and finishing including increases and decreases with minimal or no color change in simple pattern sequences. The confident crocheter has to be familiar with simple sewing stitches and simple embroidery stitches.

Material

Circulo yarns - Amigurumi
1 ball in each color #5203 greenery and #8001 white
Black yarn scraps
Crochet hook C-2
Tapestry needle #16
Safety eyes 10 mm
Polyester stuffing
Stitch marker.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
increase: inc (2 sc in the same base st)
invisible decrease: dec (insert hook into the front loops of the 2 next sts, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops)
round: rnd

Head & body

Use color #5203 greenery
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

Make a magic ring.

1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring.

2 - 6 inc (12)

3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

4 - 2 sc, 1 inc (24)

5 - 3 sc, 1 inc (30)

6 - 4 sc, 1 inc (36)

7 - 5 sc, 1 inc (42)

8 - 6 sc, 1 inc (48)

9 - 17 (9 rnds) 48 sc in each rnd.

18 - 6 sc, 1 dec (42)

19 - 5 sc, 1 dec (36)

20 - 4 sc, 1 dec (30)

21 - 3 sc, 1 dec (24)

22 - 2 sc, 1 dec (18)

Insert stuffing.

23 - 1 sc, 1 dec (12)

24 - 6 dec (6)

Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Eyes (make 2)

Eyelids

Use color #5203 greenery
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

Make a magic ring.

1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring

2 - 6 inc (12)

3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

4 - 5 sc, 1 inc (21)

5 & 6 - 21 sc in each rnd.

Fasten off.

Eye ball

Use color #8001 white

Make a magic ring.

1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring

2 - 6 inc (12)

3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

4 - 6 (3 rnds) 18 sc in each rnd

Attach safety eyes and insert stuffing.

7 - 1 sc, 1 dec (12)

Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Insert eye balls into eyelids and sew eyes onto body as shown in the picture.

Legs (make 4)

Start with color #8001 white
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

Make a magic ring.

1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring

2 - 6 inc (12)

3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)

Switch to color #5203 greenery

4 & 5 - 15 sc in each rnd.

6 - 3 sc, 1 dec (12)

Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Insert stuffing and use tapestry needle and this tail to sew legs onto body as shown in the picture.

Finishing

Use black yarn scraps to embroider mouth and nose as shown in the picture.

Approx. size: 4.75"

Level: Confident Beginner – basic and repetitive stitches with little shaping and finishing including increases and decreases with minimal or no color change in simple pattern sequences. The confident crocheter has to be familiar with simple sewing stitches and simple embroidery stitches.

Material

Circulo yarns - Amigurumi
1 ball in each color #8001 white and #8990 black
Crochet hook C-2
Tapestry needle #16
Safety eyes 10 mm
Polyester stuffing
Stitch marker.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
increase: inc (2 sc in the same base st)
invisible decrease: dec (insert hook into the front loops of the 2 next sts, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops)
round: rnd

Head & body

Use color #8001 white
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring.
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (18)

4 - 2 sc, 1 inc (24)
5 - 3 sc, 1 inc (30)
6 - 4 sc, 1 inc (36)
7 - 5 sc, 1 inc (42)
8 - 6 sc, 1 inc (48)
9 - 18 (10 rnds) 48 sc in each rnd.
19 - 6 sc, 1 dec (42)
20 - 5 sc, 1 dec (36)
21 - 4 sc, 1 dec (30)
22 - 3 sc, 1 dec (24)
23 - 2 sc, 1 dec (18)
Insert stuffing.
24 - 1 sc, 1 dec (12)
25 - 6 dec (6)
Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Eyes (make 2)

Start with color #8001 white
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 7 sc inside of magic ring.
Switch to color #8990 black
2 - 7 inc (14)
Insert safety eyes into magic ring of crocheted eyes and attach them into head as shown in the picture.

Ears (make 2)

Use color #8990 black
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)
4 & 5 - 15 sc in each rnd.
Make 1 sl st into next sc.
Fasten off with a tail for

sewing. Use tapestry needle and this tail to sew ears onto body as shown in the picture.

Legs (make 4)

Start with color #8990 black
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)
4 & 5 - 15 sc in each rnd.
6 - 3 sc, 1 dec (12)
Make 1 sl st into next sc.
Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Insert stuffing and use tapestry needle and this tail to sew legs onto body as shown in the picture.

Tail

Use color #8990 black
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)
4 & 5 - 15 sc in each rnd
6 - 3 sc, 1 dec (12)
Insert stuffing.
Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Finishing

Use black yarn to embroider nose as shown in the picture.

Approx. size: 4.5"

Level: Confident Beginner – basic and repetitive stitches with little shaping and finishing including increases and decreases with minimal or no color change in simple pattern sequences. The confident crocheter has to be familiar with simple sewing stitches and simple embroidery stitches.

Material

Circulo yarns - Amigurumi
1 ball color #3046 sweetness
Black yarn scraps
Crochet hook C-2
Tapestry needle #16
Safety eyes 10 mm
Polyester stuffing
Stitch marker.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
increase: inc (2 sc in the same base st)
invisible decrease: dec (insert hook into the front loops of the 2 next sts, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops)
round: rnd

Head & body

Use color #3046 sweetness
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring.

2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (18)
4 - 2 sc, 1 inc (24)
5 - 3 sc, 1 inc (30)
6 - 4 sc, 1 inc (36)
7 - 5 sc, 1 inc (42)
8 - 6 sc, 1 inc (48)
9 - 17 (9 rnds) 48 sc in each rnd.

Attach safety eyes between rnds 10 & 11, 8 sts apart.

18 - 6 sc, 1 dec (42)
19 - 5 sc, 1 dec (36)
20 - 4 sc, 1 dec (30)
21 - 3 sc, 1 dec (24)
22 - 2 sc, 1 dec (18)

Insert stuffing.

23 - 1 sc, 1 dec (12)
24 - 6 dec (6)
Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Tail

Use color #3046 sweetness
Ch 9, insert hook into second chain from hook: 3 sc in each chain. Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Sew tail onto back as shown in the picture.

Ears (make 2)

Use color #3046 sweetness
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 1 sc, 1 inc (9)
3 - 2 sc, 1 inc (12)
4 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)

5 - 4 sc, 1 inc (18)

6 - 5 sc, 1 inc (21)

7 - 21 sc

Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Use tapestry needle and this tail to sew ears onto body as shown in the picture.

Legs (make 4)

Start with color #3046 sweetness
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)
4 & 5 - 15 sc in each rnd.
6 - 3 sc, 1 dec (12)
Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Insert stuffing and use tapestry needle and this tail to sew legs onto body as shown in the picture.

Snout

Use color #3046 sweetness
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 7 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 7 inc (14)
3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (21)
4 - 21 sc into back loop only.
Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Use black yarn scraps to embroider nostrils. Insert some stuffing and use tapestry needle and this tail to sew snout onto face as shown in the picture.

Approx. size: 4.75"

Level: Confident Beginner – basic and repetitive stitches with little shaping and finishing including increases and decreases with minimal or no color change in simple pattern sequences. The confident crocheter has to be familiar with simple sewing stitches and simple embroidery stitches.

Material

Circulo yarns - Amigurumi
1 ball in each color #2137 hydrangea and #8176 off-white
Crochet hook C-2
Tapestry needle #16
Safety eyes 10 mm
Polyester stuffing
Stitch marker.

Stitch glossary and abbreviations:

slip st: sl st
single crochet: sc
increase: inc (2 sc in the same base st)
invisible decrease: dec (insert hook into the front loops of the 2 next sts, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo, pull through 2 loops)
round: rnd

Head & body

Use color #2137 hydrangea
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.
Make a magic ring.
1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring.
2 - 6 inc (12)

3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (18)
4 - 2 sc, 1 inc (24)
5 - 3 sc, 1 inc (30)
6 - 4 sc, 1 inc (36)
7 - 5 sc, 1 inc (42)
8 - 6 sc, 1 inc (48)
9 - 18 (10 rnds) 48 sc in each rnd.

Attach safety eyes between rnds 10 & 11, 8 sts apart.

19 - 6 sc, 1 dec (42)
20 - 5 sc, 1 dec (36)
21 - 4 sc, 1 dec (30)
22 - 3 sc, 1 dec (24)
23 - 2 sc, 1 dec (18)

Insert stuffing.

24 - 1 sc, 1 dec (12)
25 - 6 dec (6)

Use tapestry needle, weave the yarn through the front loop of each stitch in your last rnd, gently pull the yarn taught.

Ears (make 2)

Use color #2137 hydrangea
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

Make a magic ring.

1 - 4 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 4 inc (8)
3 - 1 sc, 1 inc (12)
4 - 2 sc, 1 inc (16)
5 - 16 sc

Make 1 sl st into next sc.
Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Use tapestry needle and this tail to sew ears onto body as shown in the picture.

Legs (make 4)

Start with color #8176 off-white
Crochet in the round. Close

rnds with 1 sl st.

Make a magic ring.

1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)

Switch to color #2137 hydrangea.

4 & 5 - 15 sc in each rnd.

6 - 3 sc, 1 dec (12)

Make 1 sl st into next sc.

Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Insert stuffing and use tapestry needle and this tail to sew legs onto body as shown in the picture.

Tail

Use color #8176 off-white
Crochet in the round. Close rnds with 1 sl st.

Make a magic ring.

1 - 6 sc inside of magic ring
2 - 6 inc (12)
3 - 3 sc, 1 inc (15)
4 - 15 sc

5 - 3 sc, 1 dec (12)

Insert stuffing into tip only.
6 - 13 (8 rnds) 12 sc in each rnd.

14 - 2 sc, 1 dec (9)

Make 1 sl st into next sc.
Fasten off with a tail for sewing. Insert stuffing and use tapestry needle and this tail to sew tail onto body as shown in the picture.

Finishing

Use color #8176 off-white to embroider whiskers and nose as shown in the picture.
